### Arrest & Arraignment

Accosting, enticing or soliciting child for immoral purpose

On October 28, 2016, the Auburn Hills Police Department arrested a 29-year-old man following an investigation of a man-soliciting a child for immoral purposes. Adam Hopper of Auburn Hills was arrested and arraigned on a felony charge for Accosting, enticing or soliciting child for immoral purpose. It is alleged that Hopper solicited a person under the age of 16 for sexual act.

Hopper was arraigned following his arrest at the 52-3<sup>rd</sup> District Court before Magistrate Marie A. Soma. A plea of not guilty was entered on Hopper's behalf and bond set at \$25000.00 cash, 10% allowed with a GPS tether required. A probable cause conference is set for November 10, 2016 at 8:30 am before Judge Lisa Asadoorian at 52-3<sup>rd</sup> District Court in Rochester Hills.

**Michigan Criminal Law 750.145a** Accosting, enticing or soliciting child for immoral purpose is a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 4 years or a fine of not more than \$4,000.00, or both.
