



# Auburn Hills Police Department Media Release



On July 26, 2017 at 6:45 am, officers from the Auburn Hills Police Department responded to a burglary call at 4000 Pinnacle Drive (FTE Automotive). Employees coming in to work discovered that the business had been burglarized. Computers and electronic devices were stolen from several offices within the building.

A preliminary investigation revealed that the suspect made entry into the business by breaking out an office window. The suspect appeared to be acting alone and ran from the building on foot. Several computers and electronic devices were located in an area of woods adjacent to the building.

Officers conducted a K-9 track with the assistance of the Oakland County Sheriff's Office. It appears that the suspect ran north from the business and was last known to be in the area of Brown Rd., west of Lapeer Rd.

Investigators determined the identity of the suspect from evidence collected at the scene. The suspect, a 40 year old man from Pontiac, was subsequently arrested at a residence in Orion Township by Auburn Hills Police with the assistance of deputies from the Oakland County Sheriff's Office.

The suspect will be lodged at the Oakland County Jail until the case can be reviewed by the Prosecutor's Office.
