Monthly Report: February 2020

Single Vehicle Rollover Crash

On February 13, 2020 at 04:46am, officers were dispatched to the area of northbound I-75 and University Drive for a single vehicle rollover crash.

Officers on scene smelled an odor of intoxicants coming from the driver's breath. The driver was asked to take field sobriety tasks and he performed poorly on the evaluations. The driver submitted to a preliminary breath test (PBT) which yielded a result of .164. The driver was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail on suspicion of Operating While Intoxicated.



CCW – Concealed Weapons

On February 23, 2020 at approximately 7:05pm, Officer Sears was on patrol in the area of Adams Road and Squirrel Road. Officers Sears initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle for an equipment violation. The investigation revealed that the driver was carrying a concealed weapon without a permit.

The driver was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail. The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office authorized charges for carrying a concealed weapon and driving an uninsured vehicle.

Malicious Destruction of Property

On February 7, 2020 at approximately 11:45pm, officers responded to 1294 North Opdyke Road for a disturbance.

The investigation revealed that a guest at the hotel was refusing to leave after causing extensive damage. The suspect was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail. The suspect was ultimately charged with one count of Malicious Destruction of Property 1k to 20k. The suspect was arraigned at the 52/3 District Court on February 8, 2020, and bond was set at \$10,000.00 cash.

Operating While Intoxicated and Child Endangerment

On February 10, 2020 at approximately 7:31pm, Sergeant Eftink was on patrol in the area of Joslyn Road and Taylor Road. Sergeant Eftink observed a truck doing "donuts" in a parking lot located off Joslyn Road.

Sergeant Eftink initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle and made contact with the driver, a 29 year old from Pontiac. Sergeant Eftink could smell an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath. The driver was asked to take field sobriety tasks and he performed poorly on the evaluations. The driver submitted to a preliminary breath test (PBT) which yielded a result of .214. The driver was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail. The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office authorized charges for operating while intoxicated child endangerment.

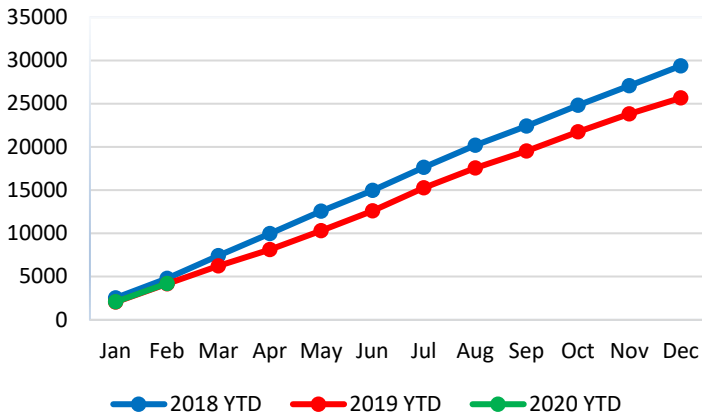
Assist Other Departments

Calls for Service

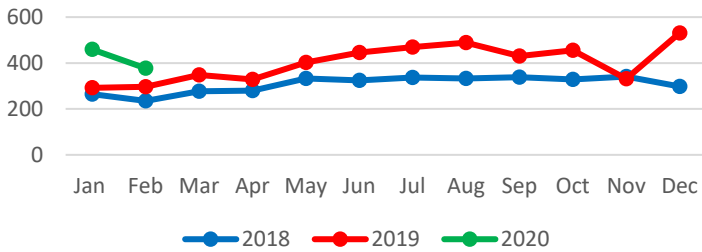
Calls for Service (Year to Date)



Officers handled 2116 calls for service during the month of February. Year to date the department has handled 4201 calls for service, which is a 1.38% increase compared to 2019 YTD.

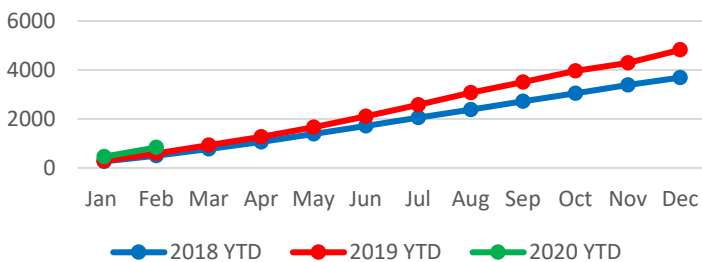
Time in Neighborhoods

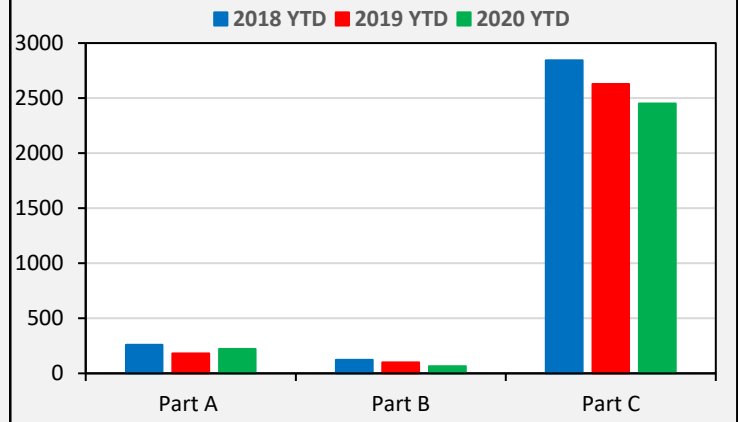
Cumulative Time in Neighborhoods (Year to Date)



Crime and Service Statistics

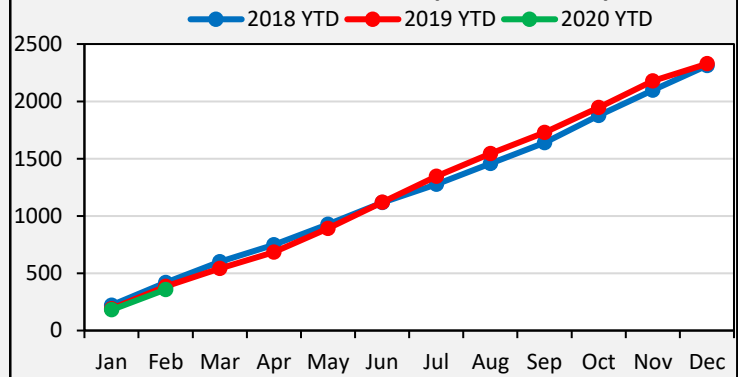
We continually strategize our responses and make the best use of the tools and personnel we have to produce the best possible outcomes.

Crime Statistics (Year to Date)



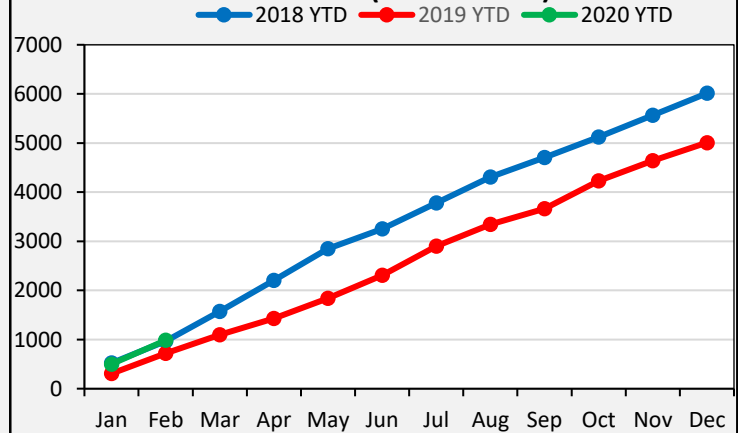
Year to date we have experienced a 23.89% increase in our Part A incidents (more serious offenses), a -36.00% decrease in our Part B incidents (non-violent misdemeanors), and a -6.81% decrease in Part C incidents (misdemeanor and service related incidents) compared to year to date 2019.

Traffic Crashes (Year to Date)



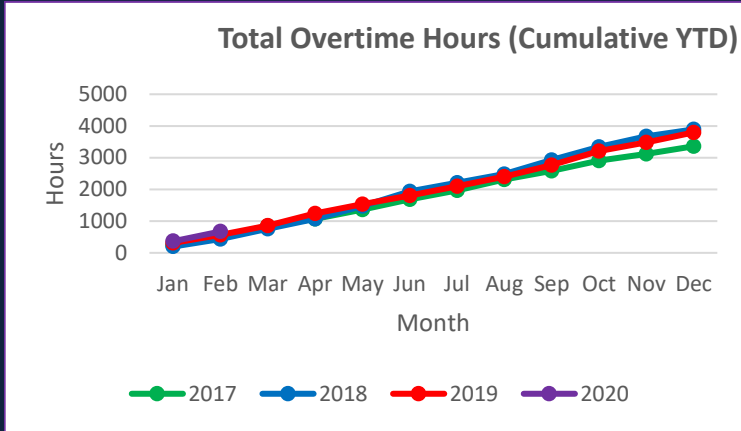
During the month of February, we handled 178 crashes. Year to date we have experienced a -6.77% decrease in traffic crashes compared to 2019.

Officers issued 484 citations in February 2020. Year to date we have experienced a 36.29% increase in citations issued compared to 2019.

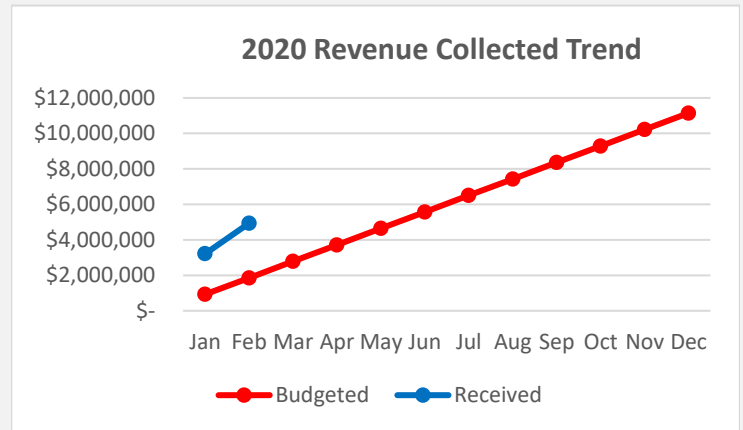
Department Overtime



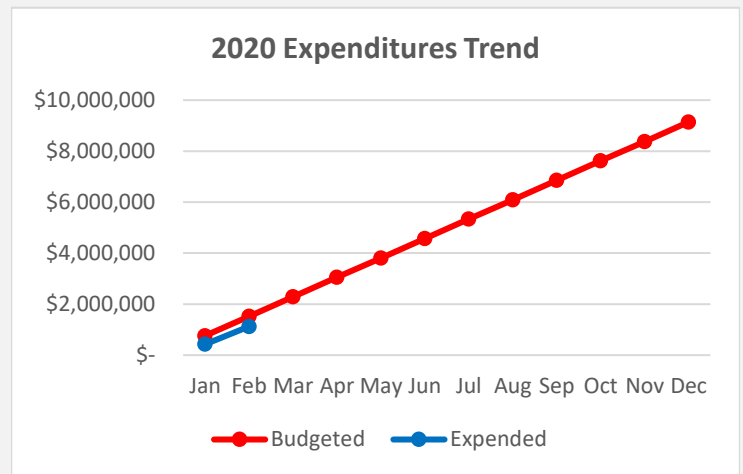
Officers worked at total of 308 hours of overtime in the month of February. This is a cumulative year to date increase in overtime of 111 hours compared to this same time last year.

During the month of February, we received \$1,721,076 in revenue. Year to date we have received \$4,935,086.



During the month of February, we expended \$1,123,464. Year to date we have expended \$1,549,523 or 74% of our approved budget. We are currently \$399,880 under budget at the end of February 2020.
