Suspect Charged with Criminal Sexual Conduct 3rd degree

On October 30, 2018, Corey Gonzalez, age 35, of Auburn Hills was charged and arraigned on three counts of Criminal Sexual Conduct in the third degree. These sexual assaults occurred at the Avondale High School, where Mr. Gonzales was a hall monitor and assistant coach. Mr. Gonzales had inappropriate and sexual relations with a student over the course of two years. The victim in this case graduated in 2018 and is no longer a student at the school.

Gonzales was arraigned at the 52/3 District Court in Rochester Hills in front of Magistrate Marie Soma. Bond was set at \$20,000 personal bond. A preliminary exam conference has been set for November 13, 2018 at 8:30 am in front of Judge Carniak. Criminal Sexual Conduct in the third degree is a felony offense punishable by up to 15 years in prison.
