Suspect Wanted in Connection with Home Invasions

The Auburn Hills Police Department is requesting the public's assistance in identifying a suspect(s) responsible for numerous Home Invasions. The Auburn Hills Police have responded to (5) Home Invasions from January 31, 2014 to February 19, 2014 in neighborhoods in the area of Walton Blvd. and Dexter Rd. These incidents have occurred at the following locations within a ½ mile radius of each other:

- 1/31/14, 2800 block of Pontiac Ct.
- 2/7/14 – 2/13/14, 2100 block of Walnut Rd.
- 2/11/14, 2100 block of Walnut Rd.
- 2/11/14, 2900 block of Edna Jane Rd.
- 2/19/14, 2900 block of James Rd.

These home invasions appear to have been committed during day time hours, Monday through Friday. In all of the incidents no one was home at the time. The suspect(s) are gaining access through unlocked doors or prying open windows. Guns, jewelry, cash, and video games are among items reported stolen.

On February 19, 2014, a resident in the area reported a possible suspect in the area of the home invasion on James Rd. The suspect left the area on foot in an unknown direction. There is no vehicle information available at this time.

Suspect is described as white male in his mid 30's, 5'11" to 6'0" tall, thin build, with brown hair and full beard and mustache. He was wearing a beige or dark brown coat with a zipper and dark blue jeans. *(The image below is a computer generated composite of the suspect.)*
