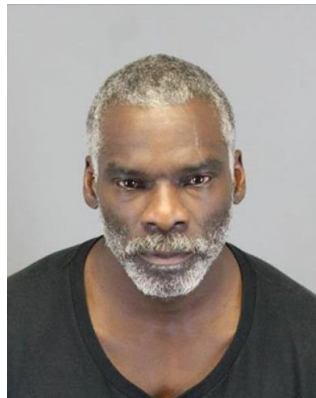
Shoplifter Charged and Arraigned

The Oakland County Prosecutors Office charges Anthony Harris, 46-year-old of Flint, Michigan with Retail Fraud First Degree. Harris was arraigned Saturday, October 10, 2015, at the 6th Circuit Court before Magistrate Andra V. Richardson. A not guilty plea, was entered on Harris' behalf and bond set at \$25,000 cash. A probable cause conference is set for October 19, 2015, at 1:15 pm at the 52-3rd District Court before Judge Nancy Tolwin Carniak. Harris remains lodged at the Oakland County Jail. The second suspect, a 52-year-old Flint area man who remains in custody on outstanding warrants from other jurisdictions pending a line-up.

Retail Fraud 1st Degree is a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 5 years or a fine of not more than \$10,000.00 or 3 times the value of the stolen property.

On October 6, 2015, at approximately 2:00 pm the Auburn Hills Police Department responded to Home Depot on Joslyn for shots fired. A 46-year-old female customer from Clarkston, Michigan was in the parking lot as the Home Depot employee was trying to stop the 52 year old, white male as he pushed a cart full of unpaid merchandise out of the store. The 52 year old, white male got into a dark colored SUV, driven by Anthony Harris and began to flee. The female customer, a concealed pistol license (CPL) holder, fired shots at the suspect vehicle as it fled flattening a tire on the vehicle.
